





## **Specialty Gardens**

Don't be afraid to add a unique garden type to your low maintenance set up. Try a cut flower garden, a moon garden (all white), an alpine garden, an herb spiral, or a butterfly garden. These can be tucked into a tiny area with a bench for a very charming effect.

#### **Dry Rivers**

- $\langle \rangle$ Can add a bubbling rock within it
- $\langle \rangle$ Use a variety of rock types
- $\Diamond$ Fit in along your property's natural drainage channels

#### Rain Gardens

Make a low area in the garden to collect water during a rain event with plants that don't mind temporarily wet feet. This will help to build up the water table.

#### **Bog Gardens**

By lining a low area of the garden with heavy clay or a pond liner with holes in it, and then filling it with topsoil and peat moss, you can create a unique environment for plants that love somewhat wet conditions like Hosta, Siberian iris, marsh marigolds, & ligularia.

#### **Water Gardens**

These are for plants that grow in various places in a pond environment and could be submerged, floating, or growing along the edge of the pond. Usually a rubber liner and filter system is required. Or try a container water garden! Because they mimic a natural ecosystem, ponds can entail some extra attention. Often the entertainment value is worth the effort. There are some awesome pond maintenance people who can assist you.
